Built in 1968, the Methodist Presbyterian Hostel (MPH) was able to house up to 80 children attending the American school (TASOK) located across the street. The parents of these children were serving in other parts of Congo (Zaire) as representatives for these two denominations. Cindy lived in this building from 1979-1983.

Today, MPH is a mission guest house. Its role is to facilitate the work and travel of mission personnel of many denominations and the broader church community engaged in partnerships or working with NGO's in the Democratic Republic of Congo.

MPH offers a variety of room accommodations and has the capacity to lodge up to 50 people. Our large conference room can hold around 60 people depending on the layout requested. The small conference room works well for up to 12 people. All our rooms have large windows looking out onto a spacious garden.
