 - **Mafuta**, Clay’s worker, has returned to work for a few hours in the mornings. He is learning to control his diabetes with diet and oral medication, though he is still quite weak.

- **Nzila**, our head cook, had his right kidney removed in a ten-hour surgery here in Kinshasa. We had to do a lot of research of the local hospitals to find one that, we felt, would give him good care. His medical team consisted of skilled local doctors and a team of visiting doctors from Belgium. He was very pleased with the quality of his care. He has been in a couple of times to see us and he looks great! We have not received results of the biopsy of the mass, but we look forward to his return on 7 January 2019.

There have been a few “hiccups” in recent weeks including a fire at the depot where thousands of voting machines were destroyed. And, of course, there are many, many rumors. We pray for peace in Congo and that the stress of the past couple of years will subside.
